Candidates should have experience operating digital consoles, mixing live bands, working with a wide variety of speaker systems and setting up wireless and wired microphones.

LIGHTING

Opportunities in Costuming

Join the Disney Costuming team, responsible for the largest working wardrobe in the world, providing the fully-themed looks and costumes that help bring Disney stories to life.

Our costumes appear on Cast Members, Performers and Characters, as well as in behind-the-scenes areas our Guests never see.

Our Costuming team hires for a variety of roles:

COSTUME ASSISTANT

Candidates should have or be working towards an Associate or Bachelor's degree in Fashion and Textile Design, Fashion Merchandising or Theatre Arts. In this role, you will support the Costumer team and tasks could include hand sewing, craft skills, fabric dyeing and set up and dressing of costumes at rehearsals, special events and conventions.

COSTUME CAM SPECIALIST

Candidates must have a thorough working knowledge of cutting, pattern making and garment construction. In this role, you could develop patterns from costume design sketches by draping, flat patterning or computer-assisted patterning. You could also be creating tech packs or digitizing and grading patterns, as well as creating markers using specialized computer software.

COSMETOLOGIST

Candidates should possess a valid Florida Cosmetologist license and have the ability to wash and set wigs and recreate complex styles from a photo. In this role, you could also assist Performers with their makeup needs.

GARMENT CUTTER

Candidates should have experience in cutting custom garments using different types of cutting equipment. This role requires experience with press equipment.
