CHILD MOANA

GRAMMA TALA

(to MOANA)
Yes, Moana?

CHILD MOANA

What's inside that shell you're always wearing?

GRAMMA TALA

I'll tell you when you're a big girl.

CHILD MOANA

But I am a big girl.

GRAMMA TALA

Not unless I'm losing my eyesight, you're not.

CHILD MOANA

Well, you're not a manta ray even though you say you are.



GRAMMA TALA

Oh yeah? Says who?

CHILD MOANA

Says most of the people in our village.

GRAMMA TALA

Then most of the people in our village don't know what they're talking about. I am a manta ray.

(MOANA spots Lasalo's new canoe out on the reef.)

CHILD MOANA

Lasalo has a new canoe.

GRAMMA TALA

For an eight year-old, you do spend a lot of time thinking about canoes.

CHILD MOANA

About as much time as you spend thinking about manta rays.

GRAMMA TALA

Well, I am the village crazy lady. What's your excuse?

CHILD MOANA

I just think it must be amazing to be on a canoe like that. To have the wind carry you to faraway places. I've never been farther than the reef.

GRAMMA TALA

Neither has Lasalo. You know your papa's rules.

TUI

(from offstage)
Moana? Moana?!

GRAMMA TALA

Speaking of...

(Tui enters.)

TUI

There you are. You can't just wander off like that.



GRAMMA TALA

She was just spending a little quality time with her gramma.

TUI

(suspiciously)
Look at the two of you. Up to no good, I suspect?

CHILD MOANA

We were just dancing.

GAMMA TALA

Nothing wrong with dancing.

CHILD MOANA

Though I did happen to notice that Lasalo has a new canoe, and I was thinking that maybe –

TUI

Here we go again with the canoes.

GAMMA TALA

Well, it is a nice canoe.
