LELEI & LASOLO

SIDE: LELEI, TUI, MOANA, LASOLO

(By the water's edge. LELEI, a female farmer, is showing Tui her crop of coconuts, as MOANA and SINA observe. LASALO, a fisherman, works nearby.)

TUI

What is it you wanted to discuss?

LELEI

It's the crop...

(LELEI opens a coconut and shows the inside to Tui.)

LELEI (CONT'D)

They're all rotten.

TUI

All of them? But they were harvested only yesterday.

LELEI

Maybe the trees are diseased?

(TUI turns to Moana.)

TUI

What do you think we should do?

MOANA

Salvage the husks? And then start a new grove on higher ground.

TUI

(proudly)
Very good.

LASALO

But this can't just be a coincidence, Chief.

MOANA

What's not a coincidence?

TUI

Let's discuss that –

LASALO

The coconuts? And the fish?

MOANA

What about the fish?

TUI

Not now, Lasalo –

LASALO

There's no fish.

MOANA

What do you mean there's no fish?

TUI

Well that's not quite what he --

LASALO

I mean there's no fish. We tried the far side of the island: no fish. The windward side: no fish. The leeward side –

TUI

No fish. We get it. This isn't the first time we've –

TUI

A rule that keeps us safe --

MOANA

TUI

(losing it)
