Character Description:

AUNTIE WINI is a loveable Hawaiian who is a little "Bloody Mary", a little "Hilo Hattie" and a lot of friendship, laughter, hospitality and fun. A beautiful smile, a warm hug and a happy laugh for everyone make her the embodiment of the true spirit of aloha.

Script:

Aloha! (She solicits the audience to respond with Aloha!)

We're gonna have our luau right out here. I had this cabana built special to fit all my friends and family.
